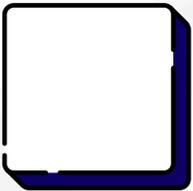
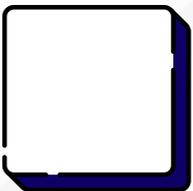

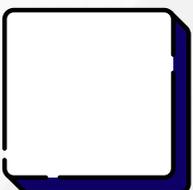
Do we treat near-misses as intelligence, not inconvenience?

If staff stop reporting them, you've already lost critical insight.



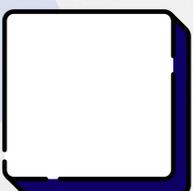
Do we resist oversimplifying complex clinical work?

Or do we default to slogans, dashboards, and hindsight explanations?



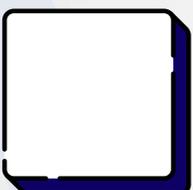
Do decisions follow expertise, and not hierarchy?
